**Course Outline:** This class is the study of American History starting from the early discovery, to the present. In this book we will cover events that has formed this nation from it's start all the way to the present, and the responsibilities the U.S. has for being the strongest Nation in the world.

**Classroom Rules:** This classroom will have a controlled learning environment. If a student is unable to behave in such a manner he/she will be subject to disciplinary actions, and possible removal from the class.

*In this class, you will be graded on:*

Test, worksheets, daily assignments, quizzes from previous notes, current events, reports, notes & classroom participation.

**Current Events:** Each week, 1 student will get up in front of the class to update the class on current events. Events should have significant value to our society. On each chapter test, there will be questions from these articles. Students will be graded on their presentation. (Worth 30 points per week)

**Folders:** each student is encouraged to keep a folder of all test during the year. Semester Test will come from all previous test.

**Notes:** Each student will be graded on their notes at the end of each semester. If a student should use a copier machine both students will lose all their points. (notes are worth 100 points per Semester)

**Test:** If a student should miss a test, he/she will have 2 days to take the test. If the student does not take the test inside of 2 days he/she will receive an automatic "F"
