Course Outline: World History is the study of mankind and human events. We will explore the progress, contributions, triumphs, and failures of mankind throughout history. We will be exploring a vast amount of time from prehistoric to the 20th century.

Content: This is a Cooperative Learning world history class. These means the students teach themselves. Each chapter the class will be broken up into groups. The group is responsible for teaching themselves each section of the chapter. After the group is done with a section of the chapter, that group will come up as a group to receive their question. Each question is worth 5 points.

Worksheets will be given to each group at the beginning of each chapter. Worksheets will be graded the day before the test.

Review: Each day before the test a game of Jeopardy will be played to review. Bonus points will be awarded to the winning teams.

Test: If a student gets below a "C" or 69%-below, that student will not be allowed in a group the next chapter, and will not be allowed back into a group until he/she gets a "C" or better.

Absent- If a student is absent, it is your responsibility to get all make up work, and missed questions. If a student misses a test he/she will have 2 days to make up that test.

Class Rules: Since this is a cooperative learning class talking is allowed among group members.

1. No talking while the teacher is talking to the class.
(respect me & I'll respect you)

2. No food, candy, gum, or pop is allowed in this classroom.

3. When the bell rings each student must be in their own seats. (unless you have a signed note from a teacher)

4. No cheating, if caught automatic "F" and parents notified.

5. No talking to other groups, if a student can't handle working in a group he/she will be removed from working in groups.

6. If you have been taken out of a group and working on your own you can't talk at all.

7. Chairs- 5 minutes before the bell each group will put their chairs back in their proper place. If a group has finished early they make work on something quietly.
